



**Door County Planning Department  
Request for Town Recommendation**

Arthur H. & Amanda K. Gibson are proposing to establish a restaurant in an existing two story building. The restaurant would be established in the first floor of the building. There is currently living quarters in the second floor of the building. The restaurant will have 34 seats available for the public. A restaurant must be authorized by a Conditional Use Permit in the Recreational Commercial (RC) zoning district.

The (circle one) Town Board / Planning Committee of the Town of WASHINGTON held a legally noticed and posted meeting on 16 November 2015, at which, by a vote of 6 (Yea) to 0 (Nay), the town recommended (check one) XX **SUPPORT**  **DENIAL** for a conditional use permit.
