

**Washington Island Parks Committee Meeting**  
**Thursday, May 3, 2012**  
**Rutledge Room, 7:00 p.m.**

**Minutes (DRAFT)**

After the call to order and Pledge of Allegiance, the Parks Committee did the following:

1. Agreed that the results of the canvass of town parks for maintenance projects to be completed before summer be sent in memo form to two members of the Town Board: Joel Gunnlaugsson, chair; and Tom Jordan, whose responsibilities include overseeing the town crew.
2. Appreciated the news from Ted Hansen, committee member and also member of the Lions Club, that Lions Club members were beginning work on the construction of additional bicycle racks for town parks; the plan is to construct 10 bike racks that will each hold 10 bicycles.
3. Discussed creating a detailed and comprehensive map of all parks and public recreation areas in the Town of Washington. Some ideas that were considered were:
  - a. Create a matrix, which might be a compact way to show what the rules and regulations of various facilities are
  - b. Put the regulations on a separate sheet that could be duplicated cheaply and could be given away
  - c. Inquire about inserting a map of town parks into the 2013 Official Visitor Guide for Door County
  - d. Find a copy of the map of public hunting areas that was done in the past
  - e. Post a comprehensive parks and public lands map on the Parks Committee's portion of the Town website; this would save on printing costs and could be downloaded
4. Agreed that future projects are expected to include planning for the Detroit Harbor area, including Gislason Beach.

The next Parks Committee meeting is scheduled for June 6, 2012.
