1. Call to Order 4 p.m.
2. Approval of June 3, 2014 minutes. Motion to accept by Randy S., 2nd by Liz. H. Motion carried.
3. No communications or correspondence.
4. Discussion/recommendations:
 - Gislason Beach** – discussion re: dogs on beach was tabled until August meeting. Public access to the water's edge for dogs are Dock Road, end of Wickman Dr., south end of Main Road. New boards are needed on picnic table on beach.
 - Public access to north end of Main Road** – town crew has cleared the path, installed new picnic tables, and spread wood chips on path.
 - Pavilion at Schoolhouse Beach** – cement pad has been laid.
 - Witness Tree** – a new sign has been installed. Ron Overdahl will research this tree and provide additional information regarding it.
 - Heritage Trail** – sign still needs to be moved closer to the road and repainted. Wood chips have not been laid on the trail at this time.
 - Sand Dunes** – A federal & state endangered species, Dunes Thistle, is growing at the park, thereby prohibiting any disturbance of the entire park.
 - Little Lake Park** – an anonymous donor has offered to fund the extension of the dock, along with a viewing area at the end. Liz H. will discuss this with the town board.
