1. Call to order 4 p.m.
2. One correction to August 18, 2014 minutes – Jill Jorgensen to join committee, not Liz Jorgensen. Motion to accept by Randy S., 2nd by Liz H. Motion carried.
3. Correspondence – letter from Kaye McClaren, Friends of Schoolhouse Beach, stated that Margaret Foss' grade school class would like to be part of 'Adopt-a-Beach' litter monitoring program down at Schoolhouse Beach.

Communication – 2 articles in the August 28, 2014 Observer had misinformation. 'No dog shall be allowed on any Town-owned swimming beaches unless such dog in on a leash.....'. should read 'No dogs are allowed on any town-owned swimming beaches....'. and 'Little Lake dock: \$300 has been donated to pay for a public pier to replace the current pier...' should read '\$300 has been donated to pay for an extension of the current dock and a viewing platform at end of dock'.

4. Discussion/recommendations:

-**Little Lake** – town crew will do the dock work. Town wants a bench and railing around the viewing platform.

-**Witness Tree** – Mike Miotke made and installed a new sign.

-**Schoolhouse Beach** – need more 'No Dog' signs. Suggest Chamber map show buoy boundaries for all watercraft to be outside of the buoys. This would include kayaks, canoes, jet skis, etc.

-**Mountain Park** – no news

Donna Benson mentioned feral cats at Jim Gau's place on Little Lake Road. Liz will talk to Town board about the situation.
