

**WI Parks Committee
MINUTES
April 27, 2015**

1. Meeting called to order at 4 PM.
2. Minutes from March 30, 2015 meeting not available.
3. Correspondence from Kaye McClaren concerning Friends of **Schoolhouse Beach** was shared. Kaye is willing to do signs for the kiosk at the pavilion at Schoolhouse Beach. Ron O. is going to provide photos for the kiosk and the picnic tables. The committee recommended 3 poster size (app. 18" x 24) photos. One subject idea was the Goodrich boats. Signs should be maintenance free.

The price for reserved rental of the pavilion is \$50.00. Money will be handled by the Town office. It was suggested that the signs list the office phone number and office hours. Jonathan will get 5 reserved signs. Large rocks will be placed to prevent cars from driving into the pavilion. One grill will be provided, as well as 2 stainless tables (24" x 60").

Last fall there had been some discussion of the REA crew and town crew doing some cleanup at the airport. Continued discussion is necessary to clarify the work needed.

Jonathan stated that chips have been distributed on the **Heritage Trail**. In the fall he hopes to take the chipper through and take out some dead wood.

Percy Park is on the county's list for a replacement of the pit toilets. Beach cleanup is questionable. The tables belong to the county and their condition is not going to be dealt with at this time.

The addition of 200' of frontage at **Sand Dunes Park** has been completed. The committee recommended some marking (fence?) to indicate the new borders of the park, and that spraying of poison ivy commence.

Wood chips have been delivered to **Boyers Bluff access**, but have yet to be spread.
