1. Meeting called to order at 4 PM.

4. **Schoolhouse Beach**... Tables under pavilion need to be kept clean. Ted Gunnlaugsson will order the bench to be installed in Cheryl G.'s honor. Garbage cans were painted by the school children. Raft being put out this week. **Mountain Park**... some discussion about the flower bed and who is responsible for maintaining it. **Heritage Trail**... sign on Lobell Point Rd. needs to be moved closer to the road for better visibility. Jonathan Mann will have Town Crew do this. Steve Waldron and Donna Benson will walk the Trail and make notes on discrepancies in the Nature Trail guide. **DC Land Trust trail** sign area on Point road is maintained by town crew. Steve Waldron's 5th & 6th grade students cleaned up brush on trail. The Trail goes from Point Rd. to Cornell's Garage but is unusable towards the garage because of wetness. **Little Lake**... large white pine behind Jacobson cabin needs to be removed but unable to find someone to do the job. **Gislason Beach**... picnic table fixed. **Percy Park**... dead trees need to be removed. County has yet to replace the pit toilets. **Ball Park**... Town Board asked Parks Comm. to write an ordinance regarding '*No dogs, with or without a leash, are allowed at the Ball Park during games, including Little League games.*' A sign will need to be made. Liz and Randy will submit this at the next Town Board meeting.

State Natural Area – Carlin's Point & Jackson Harbor Ridges... Steve Waldron, head of the WI Natural Areas Committee, clarified the responsibility of this town committee. This area is considered a State Natural Area and has a DNR #110. Certain regulations, including, but not limited to, no dogs, no bicycles or motorized vehicles, no campfires, need to be better posted. The DNR will make signs for the State Natural Area. This committee consists of Steve & Laura Waldron, Jeff & Laura Hagen, and Herb & Marianne Gibson.
