

Community Center Committee

November 3, 2014

Bill called the meeting to order at 5:15 P.M. The minutes of the last meeting, October 13th were approved with a motion by Jim and a second by Donna.

Treasurer's report: Jim Sorensen reported that there were no changes from the last meeting.

Under agenda items:

The Red Barn renovation and Town Board response. Bill reported that he had talked with Joel and Joel thought we might be able to incorporate a holding tank system for the bathrooms. Bill will check on the status with Jonathan (Town crew member) about the possibility. The vision is to side the existing structure to match the red barns, have flush toilets, a hand washing station, possibly even sidewalks with motion activated lights and an outside shower for swimmers to rinse off.

A motion was made by Bill that a \$100 visa gift card be given to her in thanks and recognition of her many years of service. Second by Donna. Jim will check at the bank to see about getting one.

There is still a need for two new members for the committee. Additional names were suggested to try.

Plans were finalized for the open house this coming Saturday. Donna will do some decorations and Donna and Lorel will write some of the ways the Rutledge Room has been used on the white board for people to see. Jim offered to donate a garbage can for this room. Each member will bring some cookies and Donna will provide the pots for the cider and coffee and bring napkins, cups, etc.

The next item was plans for the Island Party. The theme will be country and western and Donna will have more specific plans by next meeting. She said save old blue jeans, there can be bale bales, checkered table cloths, square dancing, an auction caller selling items. Country style menu – baked chicken, pulled pork, potato salad, apple pie, etc.

The meeting adjourned at 6:15 P.M.
