Update on current funds in our account- - WE ARE NOT NEGATIVE! Upon further review we have a rough 25K, not exact yet but will be by next meeting. This was all due to a clerical error in town office not by us.

Bills at large: Kickbush himself and few custom metal pieces
Kitchen still needs to be formally inspected to gain title of commercial kitchen, but Nelvie is currently occupying and cooking out of the kitchen as is.

Kitchen: New doors are needed, as well as locks (maybe jams) and possibly a propane meter. LAFORCE estimate \$6,539.00 (2) Fire rated doors plus jams. Seems high, want to get another bid to compare cost. Emily will ask town board to consider comparing one years worth of kitchen usage to last years numbers in the books before spending a couple thousand on the meter. Kitchen booked first event- Feb 14th by Island Players
If kitchen bookings continue at a steady rate, we will need to appoint a Kitchen Manager to take on this position. (Bookings, usage, paperwork, calendar) For now Emily will handle the bookings.
