

The April 7 Spring Election and Presidential Preference Primary is occurring as scheduled.

**TODAY (Thursday, April 2) is the deadline to request an absentee ballot by mail. You must be registered to vote to request an absentee ballot by mail.**

Completed ballots must be returned by 8pm on Election Day (via mail or drop off).

The Town of Washington will have a drop box that may be used today through Tuesday morning.

Look for the signs on the box near the Town Office door.

**If you are not currently registered, you may do so on Election Day (Tuesday, April 7)**

**or you may try to make an appointment at the Town for today or Friday (847-2522).**

**Best time to call is between 8am and noon.**
