The Utility District of the Town of Washington is seeking applications for one (1) part-time FLSA non-exempt Utility District "Pumper" position under the supervision of the Utility District Manager. This position is estimated to require between 500 and 1,100 hours per year (depending on demand). Approximately 70% of the hours historically occur between June and October. Work hours are dictated by customer need and can include nights, weekends and holidays. Candidate may also qualify for additional work hours within the Department of Public Works Department.

**Operator in Training – Minimum Qualifications**

1. Must be at least 18 years of age
2. Must be willing to be apprenticed for  $\pm$  2 years under the Master Operator
3. Must have a valid Wisconsin CDL with Tank Certification (or be willing and able to obtain one)
4. Must pass substance abuse screening and background check

Starting hourly rate is  $\pm$  \$20/hour, depending on relevant skills and experience.  
Progression to  $\pm$  \$30/hour with Master Operator Level L certification.
